Departure for Matera, and meeting at Pascoli Square facing Palazzo Lanfranchi at 12.00 with the authorized professional guide of Basilicata Region. The "Sassi", the ancient quarters of Matera, are now inscribed on the World Heritage List on behalf of Unesco. Matera is well known for its rock-hewn churches, some of them are also underground churches, and it becomes an impressive setting for the representation of the biblical scenes of Colossal films such as "II Vangelo secondo Matteo" by P. Pasolini, "The Passion of Christ" with the famous actor M. Gibson and the latest remake of "Ben Hur" with Jack Huston. The guide will drive you through the Casa Grotta, the Chiesa Rupestre, the 18th wine cellar and a craftsman shop. At the end of the visit we can book for you a tasting of some typical Lucan products: peperoni cruschi, the local focaccia and a glass of Aglianico, the local red wine (price not included and to be paid on the spot starting form € 25,00 pp). The excursion will last 2 hours and it is usually scheduled in English and French at 12.30 am. It is necessary to book the visit at the reception.
